

Conditions of participation European Council on Eating Disorders (ECED) 2023 in Leiden

The ECED 2023 is organized under the responsibility of GGZ Rivierduinen.

Article 1 – Application

1.1 These terms and conditions apply to all agreements with GGZ Rivierduinen about participation in ECED 2023.

1.2 Deviations from these terms and conditions are only binding if and insofar as they have been confirmed in writing by GGZ Rivierduinen.

Article 2 – Conclusion of the agreement

2.1 The agreement between GGZ Rivierduinen and the participant is concluded by sending the online registration form, or by confirmation by GGZ Rivierduinen to the participant of his registration.

2.2 By sending the online registration form, the participant declares to know and accept the conditions of participation of GGZ Rivierduinen for this conference. These terms and conditions govern the legal relationship between GGZ Rivierduinen and the participant, unless expressly agreed otherwise.

2.3 A participant as referred to in 2.1 can be both a legally authorized representative of the employer of the employee registered as a participant, and the participant himself.

2.4 By registering, the participant enters into a payment obligation.

Article 3 – Invoicing

3.1 The costs for the conference will be invoiced in advance. The invoice can only be paid online immediately upon registration.

3.2 If any payment term prescribed in this condition or separately agreed upon is exceeded, the participant is immediately in default by operation of law without further notice of default.

3.3 If the participant does not meet the payment obligation on time, GGZ Rivierduinen reserves the right to exclude the participant from participation in the conference. The participant remains liable at all times for fulfilling his payment obligation.

3.4 Invoices will be sent after registration via the online registration form to the e-mail address provided by the participant.

Article 4 – Cancellation by the participant

4.1 The participant has the right to cancel participation in the congress.

4.2 Cancellation can only be made by e-mail. Telephone cancellations must always be confirmed in writing by the participant. GGZ Rivierduinen will always send a confirmation of that cancellation upon receipt of a cancellation.

4.3 After the date of registration, a statutory cooling-off period of 14 days applies: within that period, the participant can cancel free of charge. If the participant has already paid, the participant will receive the registration fees back. This cooling-off period also applies if the participant books the conference, and the company or employer pays for it. If the company concludes the contract, there is no cooling-off period.

Article 5 – Interim termination by the participant

5.1 In the event that the participant terminates participation in the interim after the start of the conference or will otherwise no longer participate in the activity, the participant is liable to pay the full costs and is not entitled to any refund or remission.

Article 6 – Replacement

6.1 The participant can instead of allowing another person to participate in the congress in consultation, only if the replacement is communicated to GGZ Rivierduinen before the start date of the activity and the replacement participant meets the admission conditions if these are required for participation.

6.2 In the event of interim termination, there is no right to send an alternate.

Article 7 – Cancellation, postponement and refusal by GGZ Rivierduinen

7.1 GGZ Rivierduinen reserves the right to make substantive changes to the program. This means that the speaker line-up can be adjusted. In the event of any changes, GGZ Rivierduinen will make every effort to guarantee the quality of the program.

7.2 GGZ Rivierduinen reserves the right to cancel or postpone the congress if GGZ Rivierduinen deems sufficient reason to do so. GGZ Rivierduinen does not accept any liability for damage caused by adjustment or postponement. GGZ Rivierduinen undertakes to announce the cancellation or postponement to the participants no later than 1 week before the start.

7.3 If GGZ Rivierduinen considers sufficient reason to do so, GGZ Rivierduinen may decide to hold (part of) the congress at a different location than originally communicated.

7.4 In the event of a change of date of the conference by GGZ Rivierduinen, the participant will not owe any amount if the changed date is not convenient. In that case, the participant can cancel the activity free of charge.

7.5 GGZ Rivierduinen also has the right to refuse a participant for its own reasons, in which cases the participant is entitled to a refund of the full amount paid by GGZ Rivierduinen.

Article 8 – Liability

8.1 Insofar as GGZ Rivierduinen is liable for any damage, this liability is limited to compensation for direct damage and to a maximum of the amount covered by the liability insurance of GGZ Rivierduinen and to a maximum of the amount of the registration fee per participant, with which the damage is related.

8.2 GGZ Rivierduinen is not liable for indirect damage – calamities, damage, accidents and the resulting consequential damage, if these are caused or made possible by the actions or omissions of third parties or by force majeure.

Article 9 – Force majeure

9.1 In the event of shutdown, cancellation, modification or rescheduling of the congress due to force majeure, the obligations of GGZ Rivierduinen to carry out the event will be suspended.

9.2 Force majeure is – in addition to what is stipulated in the law and in case law – understood: any unforeseen circumstance that GGZ Rivierduinen has not reasonably taken into account or did not have to take into account, as a result of which the congress cannot take place according to standards of reasonableness and fairness, such as cancellation or shutdown at the direction of the government, total or partial strikes, fire, illness and accident of the persons involved in the execution of the event (without adequate replacement being possible in the short term).

9.3 In the event of cancellation, shutdown, modification or rescheduling of an event due to force majeure, GGZ Rivierduinen will do everything that can reasonably be expected to offer a suitable solution. In the event of force majeure, GGZ Rivierduinen is not obliged to pay compensation and Article 7.4 does not apply.

Article 10 – Complaints

10.1 If a participant has a complaint about the content or organization of the conference, he or she can send it by e-mail to GGZ Rivierduinen (e.vanfurth@rivierduinen.nl).

10.2 Any complaints will be handled in accordance with the Complaints Procedure of GGZ Rivierduinen.

Article 11 – Copyright

11.1 The copyright to the congress, as well as the copyright to all information on the website www.ecedleiden2023.eu rests with GGZ Rivierduinen. The copyright on the PowerPoints and pdfs of the handouts of the various presentations rests with the respective speakers. None of this may be reproduced or made public, in any form or in any way, without written permission from GGZ Rivierduinen or the speaker in question.

Article 12 – Photos and images

12.1 During meetings, photos and/or recordings may be taken that will later be used in the communication of the event. The user rights of this visual material (the intellectual property right) belong to GGZ Rivierduinen, therefore this material can be used without any restrictions.

12.2 By accepting these general terms and conditions, the participant agrees to the fact that photos and or images of the participant can be taken.

12.3 If the participant and third parties do not agree to the posting of photos taken and or images on which he / she can be identified, a request can be submitted for the removal of these photos and / or images by sending an email to: e.vanfurth@rivierduinen.nl.

Article 13 – Disclaimer

13.1 Although the congress is compiled with care, neither the speakers nor GGZ Rivierduinen accept any liability for damage caused by any inaccuracies or imperfections in the content of the congress or the social activities.

Article 14 – Privacy statement

14.1 The necessary registration of GGZ Rivierduinen is limited to contact details (name, address, email, and telephone).

This data is used by us for the following purposes:

- to register for and keep informed of the congress,
- for drawing up and sending the corresponding invoice,
- for sending emails to participants.

14.2 For the processing of the data mentioned in 14.1, we use the services of external parties.

However, these parties will not process this data for their own purposes, nor sell it or make it available to others in any other way.

14.3 GGZ Rivierduinen handles the participant data with care and only uses it for the execution of the specific agreement. Data will not be made available to third parties.

14.4 GGZ Rivierduinen only sends emails to people who have registered for this or who have used our services. Each email contains a link with which you can immediately unsubscribe from future emails.

14.5 Data will not be kept longer than necessary to achieve the above purposes, unless there is a legal obligation that requires longer storage (such as the fiscal retention obligation for payment data).
